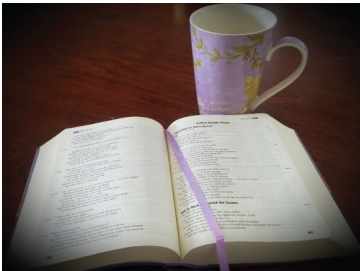
Confirmation Starts September 12th 10:15AM
